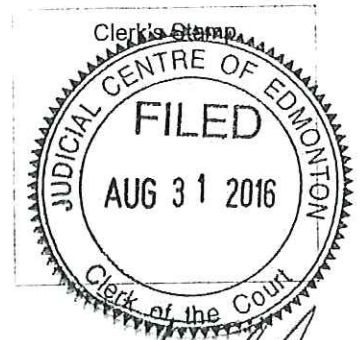

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Applicant the Alberta Motor Vehicle Industry Council; AND UPON HEARING READ the affidavit of [REDACTED] filed; AND UPON HEARING representations from Counsel for the Applicant; AND UPON HEARING representations from Martin Hausner, nobody appearing as counsel on behalf of 1292709 Alberta Ltd.;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. An injunction is granted pursuant to s. 156 of the Fair Trading Act, RSA 2000 s. F-2 (the "FTA") enjoining the Respondents and each of them from engaging in the automotive business within the Province of Alberta until properly licensed in accordance with the FTA and the *Automotive Business Regulation* (AR 178/99);
2. The Respondents shall, within three (3) days of this Order, cause all content to be removed from the Internet website hosted at the url: www.edmimports.com and the Respondents, whether acting individually or by their directors, officers, servants, agents or otherwise, are enjoined from operating the internet website located at the url: www.edmimports.com or any other similar website for the advertising and sale of vehicles or any other aspect of an automotive business until further order of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta;
3. Upon the Respondents or either of them being in breach of any of the terms of this Order, any Police Officer is authorized to forthwith arrest the person in Breach of this Order and bring the person in breach of this Order, as soon as possible, before a Justice of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta to show any reason why there should not be a

finding of civil contempt. However, the person in breach of this Order shall not be arrested unless he or she has been previously served with a copy of this Order, or if not served, is shown a copy of this Order by the Police Officer, and on being given an opportunity to do so, does not then obey it.

4. In making an arrest under this Order, a Police Officer is authorized to do anything necessary to carry out the arrest, including the use of as much reasonable force as may be necessary to make the arrest, and without warrant to enter any place where, on reasonable and probable grounds, the Police Officer believes that any person in breach of this Order may be found.

5. The Respondents shall ^{have} pay the ~~Solicitor-client~~ costs of this Application ^{in the amount of \$500.00}

6. Approval of the form of order by the Respondents is dispensed with pursuant to Rule 9.4 (2)(c) of the Rules of Court.
