DIRECTOR'S ORDER UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE *CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT*

TO

Bobby SADOWSKI

AND

ANY EMPLOYEE, REPRESENTATIVE, OR AGENT OF THE ABOVE

This Director's Order was issued under Section 157(1) of the *Consumer Protection Act* in response to, in the opinion of the Director, contraventions of the Act. As mandated by Section 157(3) a person or publisher who is subject to an order under this section may appeal under Section 179.

Pursuant to Section 179, to appeal the order, the person must serve the Minister of Service Alberta with a notice of appeal within **thirty (30) days** after receiving the order. Please include your name, your address for service, details of the order being appealed and your reasons for appealing.

The Alberta Motor Vehicle Industry Council ("AMVIC") has identified the following issue during the course of an investigation.

Bobby SADOWSKI, of 2025682 Alberta Ltd. (dba Pro-Tech Truck and RV Accessories Ltd., Pro-Tech Tire & Repair and/or Pro-Tech Tirecraft), is conducting automotive service and repairs without the required AMVIC business licence.

The contravention is as follows:

Licence required – designated business

104(1) *Consumer Protection Act* (CPA)

No person may engage in a designated business unless the person holds a licence under this *Act* that authorizes the person to engage in that business.

DIRECTOR'S ORDER

That Bobby SADOWSKI, doing business as Pro-Tech Truck and RV Accessories Ltd., Pro-Tech Tire & Repair and/or Pro-Tech Tirecraft and any other employee, representative or agent **immediately cease engaging in the automotive sales industry** within the Province of Alberta until properly licensed as per Section 104(1) of the *Consumer Protection Act* ("CPA").

Bobby Sadwoski, must immediately:

1. Cease engaging in the automotive repair business while unlicensed to do so under Section 104(1) of the *Consumer Protection Act*.

2. Remove all automotive repair related advertisements on Kijiji, Autotrader, Facebook and/or any other forms of mass communication.

NON COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE *CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT* CONTRAVENES THIS ACT AND IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND MAY BE PROSECUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 163 OF THE *CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT*.

REFUSAL, SUSPENSION, CANCELLATION, TERMS

SECTION 127(b)(i) *CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT* STATES:

THE DIRECTOR MAY REFUSE TO ISSUE OR RENEW A LICENCE, MAY CANCEL OR SUSPEND A LICENCE AND MAY IMPOSE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON A LICENCE FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- (i) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 129 OR 157, UNLESS, IN THE CASE OF AN ORDER UNDER SECTION 129 OR 157, THE ORDER HAS BEEN STAYED.
